But the feast remains a holyday and I have asked all our pastors to arrange for the celebration of a Mass for the feast of the Assumption at a convenient hour on the morning of August 15. I sense that there is some misunderstanding about the cancellation of the obligation. Some presume the holyday is also not being observed. The obligation is cancelled to provide some relief for priests who have multiple parishes and would find it difficult to schedule a full slate of Masses for the holyday.

Here in the Catholic family we have a great

devotion to Mary. The Solemnity of her Assumption during these summer days has been a treasured day of worship in many faith communities over the years. During this *Year for Priests* I invite all our people to attend Mass that morning and to pray for our priests so that we might grow in holiness and that the Lord will bless us with an increase in priestly vocations to strengthen our evangelizing mission. Our priests and seminarians will be uppermost in my heart and prayers that day. God bless.
