## ABOUT FR. PASCHAL UCHENNA EZURIKE.

*Rev. Fr. Paschal Uchenna Ezurike was born and raised in Orlu, Imo State, Nigeria. He is the first of eight children. Both parents are alive. He was ordained a Catholic Priest for the Diocese of Orlu, Nigeria, on August 26, 1995 after the completion of his seminary formation. Fr. Paschal studied Philosophy at St. Joseph's Major Seminary, Ikot- Ekpene (1987 – 1991) and Theology at Bigard Memorial Seminary, Enugu (1991- 1995), both in Nigeria.*

*After his ordination, he served as a parochial vicar for 2yrs and as a Pastor for 10yrs in his diocese in Nigeria. Also he has been entrusted with other major assignments in his*

*diocese. He came into this country in the fall of 2007 at the request of his Bishop and did a year residency program in Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE), at Oregon State Hospital, Salem. He helped out at St. Joseph's Parish, Salem from Sept. 2007 – June, 2008.*

*He was moved to St. Anthony Parish, Tigard in July 2008, as a parochial vicar for a year, from there he was moved to St Anne Parish, Grants Pass to continue his pastoral ministry in the Archdiocese of Portland.*

*Continue to pray for Fr. Paschal and all the priests as they carry out their priestly ministry.*

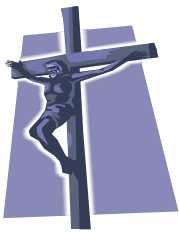
