February 1, 2009—Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Parish Community,

Perhaps you have heard that there is a new translation for the *Roman Missal* that is being prepared. The *Roman Missal* is the liturgical text used for the celebration of Mass. The translation, like the one we currently use, is a translation of the Latin text. The new translation is from the *editio typica tertia* (third typical edition). This new translation is going to be even more faithful to the original Latin text. It will be marked by a heightened style of English speech and a grammatical structure based on the Latin text. It will restore some of the poetic and biblical images evoked by the Latin text.

Several groups are involved in this new translation. On behalf of the conferences of bishops of English speaking countries, ICEL (the International Commission on English in the Liturgy) has been chartered to prepare the English texts. On the Vatican's side of things, the text is looked over by the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Congregation for the Discipline of the Sacraments for approval. These congregations are aided by a special commission called *Vox Clara* (clear voice), insuring the integrity of the text.

ICEL submits the texts to the bishops so that they can offer suggestions and comments. Then a second draft is submitted to the conferences of bishops for approval or modification and it is then sent to the Vatican for approval.

Recently the United States Catholic Conference of Bishops (USCCB) was granted *recognitio* for the new English translation for significant parts of the *Ordo Missae* (Order of the Mass) as found in the *Roman Missal*. The USCCB has provided significant portions of the new translation for our formation that we might prepare ourselves for this new translation. So, over the next few months, I will be going over this new translation with you to prepare you for when this new translation is promulgated by the Holy See.

I personally am very excited about this new translation, and I hope you will share my excitement as we look at some of the changes together over the next couple of months.
