MASS SCHEDULES

January 25, 2009—Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Parish Community,

The United States Catholic Bishops are sponsoring a nationwide campaign to send post cards to members of Congress urging them to oppose the most pro-abortion legislation ever suggested in American history. At their November meeting, the bishops unanimously voted to “mobilize the resources of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), dioceses and the entire Catholic community: to retain current pro-life laws and policies, oppose federal funding and promotion of abortion, including the possibility of the passage of a “Freedom of Choice Act (FOCA), or any such similar pro-abortion measure. They are asking “concerned citizens” to send post cards to their elected Congressional representatives.

With the convening of the 111th Congress, many pro-life laws and policies are subject to attack and reversal. According to our bishops, “If abortion advocates and their allies in Congress have their way, the ‘right’ to abortion will actually expand, for the first time making abortion a federal entitlement that the government must fund and promote.” If FOCA-type legislation is passed, laws protecting the rights, health and safety of women and their unborn children would be invalidated and at the same time endanger the constitutional rights of health care providers by forcing them to perform abortions in their health care institutions. Such an Act would also strike down federal and state laws, including informed consent laws, waiting periods, parental consent and notification laws, health and safety regulations for abortion clinics, requirements that licensed physicians

perform abortions, bans on partial-birth abortion, and bans on abortion after “viability.”

In addition to a FOCA-type bill, current legislation keeping government agencies funded expires in March, making one of Congress' first orders of business to approve an omnibus appropriations bill funding these agencies through September 30, 2009. Some other bills which will be considered at the end of this month and in February include proposals to reverse existing pro-life provisions, such as the ban on funding abortions through the Federal Employees Health Benefits Program. In March, Congress will begin drafting new appropriations bills for the 2010 Fiscal Year, and all pro-life protections in these bills will be subject to reversal by simply not including them.

This weekend, you will be asked to sign three post cards to be sent to our two Senators and Congressional Representative at all Masses in our tri-Parish communities, asking them to make protecting and supporting life, as well as the health and well-being of all Americans, a national priority, beginning with the most vulnerable, the child in the womb, and to oppose any policies meant to increase abortion in our communities. Further we must augment our actions with our prayers. Let no one silence you in our constitutional right to vote by our voices and making our views known, especially defending everyone's constitutional right to life itself.
