Sacred Heart Parish has approximately 455 families and a kindergarten through eighth grade school. Gervais is located roughly between Salem and Woodburn along 99E. For those of you who want exact coordinates: the church is at latitude 45.1097222 and longitude 122.9011111. As you can see, my new assignment has not made me lose my sense of humor.

Please pray that I will be a good pastor for my new congregation, and I will pray for you that you may be the saints that God is calling you to be.
