October 18, 2009— TWENTY-NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Parishioners,

It was great to see everyone after the long summer! Mid High will be meeting every Wednesday evening from 7PM-8:30PM in the Parish Center.

All the young people were happy, full of fun and bright eyed. Kathy had some good group activities that helped us make some new friends and learn a bit about each other.

Several students were looking towards finishing their sacramental prep. DRE Terry told the interested students she would tailor an individual program for each person, depending on needs and knowledge. Terry mentioned that the main thing for sacramental prep completion this year, for starters, is to attend youth group and Sunday Mass regularly with your friends and family. The rest comes naturally after that.

Esperanza has been very successful with gathering in the Hispanic youth into the various ministries. Several new families are now sending their kids to mid high youth group.

The Knights of Columbus has begun a serious effort to minister to the young people of the parish. A focus group has been meeting, with several good ideas discussed that will be implemented throughout the year. Some were as simple as encouraging young people to come and help with the many good service projects the Knights are presently involved in. Others were the initiation of some new

youth minded activities.

Fr. Bill gave a nice talk about the youth being more involved in the Church. He mentioned several youth service opportunities in church ministries, and shared with the youth what his expectations of them are.

Hans talked a little bit about what middle school youth are to expect in the future in the high school program. Besides having a good volleyball serve, Hans has a great confirmation program planned that is meeting on Wednesday nights this year.

When Mark and Kathy asked the youth to raise their hand if they knew anybody at school who was smoking cigarettes, smoking marijuana, drinking alcohol, engaged in sexual activities, or stealing; every student raised their hand at one question or another. Our youth all knew “**that kid**” who was involved in poor choices.

Fr. Bill nodded at the results of that short survey. The Pastor mentioned to the young people that the answer to all those problems, and many more...could be found right here at St. Anne Church.
