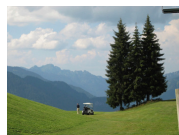

What is ACH?

ACH stands for Automated Clearing House and is the financial industry term which governs a funds transfer system for interbank clearing of electronic entries between banks, credit unions, and other financial institutions. **For our purposes, it is a very convenient and secure method of automatic giving to the church.** Many of you already do automatic bill paying online through your bank, and this is a variation of that. The ACH method we encourage everyone to set up is really very simple for you. All you need to do is stop by the office during regular business hours, or get one of the forms from the vestibules, give me a voided check, and complete the one-page form giving me authority to establish your regular, automatic giving to the church. I do everything else from the privacy of my office. You decide the amount of your regular donation and whether you want the automatic withdrawal to occur from your bank on a weekly (our preference), twice monthly, or monthly basis. Your donation to the church offertory, also known as the Parish Offertory Program, is credited to the church whether you are on vacation or cannot attend Mass due to illness or other conflicts. This method is the safest, most secure, most private, and most confidential manner for you to make your contributions to the church. Of course, we still post your donations to your individual account in order to offer you an annual summary of your donations for tax purposes. I believe you will find this "set it and forget it" way of regular giving to the church to be most convenient for you. If you have any questions, please call me at 541-476-2240.
